

Nothing quite beats a fantastic hotel stay. From modern finishes to unique amenities, we all have our reasons for why we love hotels. But where are the best hotels of 2017? We checked around the world and found a few that need to be on your radar. Note that many of these hotels aren't online yet so check our hotel search engine later to find the best prices when they become available.

Hotel X Toronto, Canada

Set to open in the fall of 2017, Hotel X Toronto is one of the most anticipated luxury hotel openings happening in Toronto. Hotel X is the city's first urban resort with the crown jewel being the 3-storey, rooftop Peregrine SkyBar. Guests will have access to two rooftop pools, a 3000 sq. ft. children's play centre, a 90,000 sq. ft. athletic facility, over 60,000 sq. ft. of meeting space, 7 restaurants, bars, and lounges. These amenities are usually found just at resort properties making it an attractive hotel for any audience.



IBEROSTAR Club Palmeraie Marrakesh, Morocco

The IBEROSTAR Club Palmeraie Marrakesh saw an extensive renovation in 2017, and the new design is simply breathtaking. Located in the heart of Marrakesh's Palm Grove, guests will have their own private oasis while being just 15 minutes from all of the top attractions in the city centre. On-site you will find three swimming pools, an 11-hectare Mediterranean garden, mini club for kids, and spa.



AC Hotel Montreal

The super chic and minimalist European inspired brand, AC Hotels is making their Canadian debut later this year in Montreal. Located downtown, what makes this hotel different is their focus on the best stays possible. Instead of room service, guests will have access to a European inspired breakfast, quick snacks, and tapas plates in the evening. Rooms will have all the modern amenities that you would expect, but you may find yourself spending more time in the lounge where you can relax or ask the bartender for expert local advice.




Margaritaville Resort Orlando

Currently tracking to open later in the year, the new Margaritaville Resort Orlando will feature a private beach, wellness center, and a 12-acre water park. Not only will the resort be located just a few minutes from Walt Disney World, it'll also be within walking distance to one of Orlando's newest retail experiences. There will be 1,000 Margaritaville-themed vacation homes, 300 timeshare units, and 187 hotels rooms available for those who want to experience Jimmy Buffet's paradise to life.



The Curtain - London

Shoreditch has quickly become one of the trendiest neighbourhoods in London so it was only a matter of time before some fantastic hotels opened up in the area. The Curtain blends luxury and style while fitting in perfectly in this artsy area. The 120 room hotel has exposed brick walls, hardwood floors, modern lighting, and custom artwork in each room. All guests will also have access to a Moroccan-style rooftop pool, a 24-hour gym, a restaurant from New York chef Marcus Samuelsson, and a live performance space.



Gran Hotel Manzana Kempinski - Havana

In recent years, Havana has seen a revolution of a different sort. Luxury hotels have moved into old buildings and have renovated them back to their former glory. The Gran Hotel Manzana Kempinski is the most recent addition of luxury hotels to sit near Havana's Parque Central. The hotel has 246 rooms with high ceilings and French windows that open out to the city. Depending on which room you're staying in, you'll get stunning views of two UNESCO World Heritage sites; the Capitol and Great Theatre of Havana.



Lucky Dragon Hotel & Casino - Las Vegas

The Lucky Dragon Hotel & Casino is Las Vegas' first casino designed from ground up that creates an authentic Asian gaming and cultural experience. Opened in late 2016, the property features popular games such as Baccarat and Pai Gow, an Emerald Room for high-limit gaming, and even an indoor / outdoor Tea Garden where you'll find the only tea sommelier in all of Las Vegas. The five restaurants on property are all Asian inspired while signs are in multiple Asian languages, and English, to accommodate guests.




Adare Manor Hotel & Golf Resort - Ireland

Our list of the best new hotels in 2017 includes a castle! The Adare Manor Hotel & Golf Resort is an award winning, 5-star hotel that is set to complete its massive renovation this November. Once complete, the property will have 104 rooms with double sinks, a separate bath and walk in shower, complimentary soft drinks, and free WiFi. The new pool overlooks the River Maigue while the La Mer spa is the only one of its kind in the UK and Ireland and becomes one of the eleven La Mer spas worldwide.



The DOUGLAS, Autograph Collection - British Columbia

Opening in September in Vancouver, The DOUGLAS pays attention to the details, which is what makes the Autograph Collection famous. The hotel's interiors are designed by acclaimed Celano Design Studio with natural element trims that line the lobby and hallways. Social spaces within the hotel will encourage guests to reconnect with people and the environment. Of particular note is the sixth floor lobby bar that leads out to an urban forest. Rooms feature local artwork, a 55" HDTV with Netflix, and convenient connection points for modern travellers.



Le Blanc Spa Resort - Los Cabos

Set to debut in the fall, the Le Blanc Spa Resort is an all-inclusive, adults-only resort located in Mexico's Baja California peninsula by Los Cabos. The 373-room resort will feature a stunning lobby full of elegance while the rooms will be full of luxury offerings. There will be 7 world-class restaurants serving a variety of international dishes and 5 bars where you can lounge around. For a little R&R, head to Awe Spa or the Laze pool with a drink in hand.
